# Main Street

Nine new business have opened up on Elm Street. The Main Street program has also assisted downtown through over 6,250 volunteer hours and with projects that have resulted in over \$1 million being invested into downtown spaces.

## RECENT GROWTH:

- **Two major rehabilitation projects were completed** at 176 S. Elm Street and 152 S. Elm Street. Two more should be completed by the end of the year.
- **New businesses in Avoca are locating in the downtown area**, including Town and Country Credit Union and Insuractive.
- **The Main Street program is also leading an effort to recruit three new businesses** with grant funding of up to \$10,000.
- **Successful programs** such as Avoca Main Street Farmers Market and Longest Table.
